1. How did Lot respond to meeting the two strangers at the gate of the city of Sodom and their plan to spend the night in the open square in Genesis 19?
2. How did the men of the city respond when they heard these strangers were staying at Lot's house? What was Lot's initial misguided attempt to appease them?
3. Once the angels told Lot that he and his family needed to flee the city before God destroyed it, how did Lot's sons-in-law respond to his attempts to get them to leave? Why did they possibly respond as they did?
4. How did Lot's wife fail to obey God's command through the angels? What was the result?
5. How did Lot's daughters take matters into their own hands even after everything they had witnessed?
6. Even though each of us is responsible for our own choices, how do you think Lot's choice to compromise and live in Sodom made it easier for his family to make the sinful choices they did?

7. Is there some area of your life where you have compromised what you know to be right? How could your choice affect others close to you?

8. Is there some area or some circumstance where you realize "it's time to go"?

9. How did Abraham demonstrate his lack of complete trust in God in Genesis 20?

10. How did God protect His plan despite Abraham's and Sarah's failure?

11. What did you learn from today's reading in Psalm 6?

12. What does it mean to bind mercy and truth around your neck in Proverbs 3.3? What does it mean to write them on the tablet of your heart?

13. What did you learn about God's view of authority from the story of the centurion in Matthew 8?

14. What did you take away from the story of the two demon-possessed men beginning in Matthew 8.28?

15. On what do you need to study and meditate so they can become more a part of your thinking and behavior?
