3. In what ways do we see God's sovereignty at work in the events of Exodus 2?
4. In what ways have you seen God's sovereignty at work in your own life when things looked hopeless?
5. According to Psalm 15.1-5, what are the qualities of a person who can dwell in God's presence?
6. How do these qualities demonstrate the fruit of a relationship with God?

7. As you reflect on the qualities mentioned in Psalm 15, which areas do you feel challenged to grow in personally?
  
8. As you read Proverbs 4.25-27, how can you remain steadfast in your walk with God?
  
9. What does Matthew 17.22-23 reveal about the disciples and their understanding of Jesus' purpose and mission?
  
10. What do those verses reveal about Jesus' understanding of all that would happen?
  
11. How do you think you would have responded if you were one of the disciples?
