- 7. As you reflect on the qualities mentioned in Psalm 15, which areas do you feel challenged to grow in personally?
- 8. As you read Proverbs 4.25-27, how can you remain steadfast in your walk with God?
- 9. What does Matthew 17.22-23 reveal about the disciples and their understanding of Jesus' purpose and mission?
- 10. What do those verses reveal about Jesus' understanding of all that would happen?
