- 1. What instructions does God give to Moses and Aaron before the first plague in Exodus 7? How do they carry out these instructions?
- 2. In what ways do we see God's authority and power displayed in this passage?
- **3.** What is Pharaoh's response to each of the first four plagues in chapters 7 and 8 of Exodus? Why does he harden his heart, and what does this reveal about his character?
- 4. Describe the third and fourth plagues (gnats/lice and flies). How do they differ from the previous plagues?
- 5. Describe the psalmist's prayer in Psalm 7.1-7.
- 6. How does the phrase in verse 7, "O You who save those who trust in You" describe the character of God?

- 7. What does Matthew 19.1-12 teach us about divorce?
- 8. Why did Jesus say Moses allowed divorce?
- **9.** Describe the interaction between Jesus and the children in Matthew 19.13-15. How do the disciples react, and what is Jesus' response?
- **10.** Summarize the encounter between Jesus and the rich young ruler in Matthew 19.16-30. What question does the young man ask, and how does Jesus respond?
- 11. Why does Jesus challenge the young man to sell his possessions and give to the poor? What does this reveal about the nature of discipleship?
- 12. Are there things in your life that may hinder your commitment to following Jesus wholeheartedly?
