1. Do you tend to judge the motives of others? Do you often think you know their intentions when they say or do something?
2. What is the difference between judging hearts and judging sin? Why are there times when we must do the latter?
3. Why is it so important to take the logs out of our own eyes (Matt. 7.5)?
4. What verse is sometimes called "the golden rule"?
5. Reread Matthew 7.21-23. What did you learn about the people described there?
6. Do you feel confident about your relationship with God?
7. What does building your house on the rock include (Matt. 7.24-27)?

8. In Genesis 17 the Lord spoke to Abraham and confirmed the covenant that He had made with him. Among other things, that he would have a son even in his old age. In Genesis 18, He appeared to Him accompanied by two angels. This time He was specific about when the promised son would be born. But Abraham's tent wasn't their last stop. Where were they going and what was the reason?

9. What was Abraham's response and the Lord's promise to him?

10. Is there someone in your circle of influence caught up in a homosexual or sexually immoral lifestyle? Do you need to be more faithful to pray for them to come to know the Lord?

11. Proverbs 2.10-22 says wisdom and discretion will keep us from sinful, foolish behavior. What stood out to you from this passage?

12. What impacted you the most from today's study? On what verse or passage should you meditate?
