1. What significance does the Ark of the Covenant hold in the Israelites' journey and relationship with God (Ex. 25.10-22)? How does the design of the Ark reflect God's holiness and presence?
2. What is the symbolism behind the bread on the Table of the Presence (Showbread) (Ex. 25.23-30)?
3. What does the Golden Lampstand represent in terms of spiritual illumination (Ex. 25.31-40)?
4. What is the significance of the veil in the Tabernacle (Ex. 26.31-37), especially considering its later tearing during Jesus' crucifixion (Matt. 27:51)?
5. List the attributes of God's Word mentioned in Psalm 19.7-9. How do these attributes reflect the nature and character of God?
6. Why does the psalmist compare God's Word to gold and honey (Ps. 19.10)? What does this reveal about the value and sweetness of Scripture?

7. How can you cultivate a greater desire for God's Word in your life? What practical steps can you take to prioritize Scripture reading and meditation?

8. According to Proverbs 6.32, what are the consequences of committing adultery?

9. In what ways do the consequences of adultery impact not only the person involved but also their reputation (Prov. 6.33)?

10. What signs did Jesus give regarding the end times in Matthew 24, and why did He caution against being alarmed by them?

11. What warnings and encouragement does Jesus provide for discerning false prophets and false signs in Matthew 24?

12. In what ways can the anticipation of Christ's return impact the way you live your life today?

13. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
