Exodus 31 & 32

Psalm 21.1-7

1. After giving Moses all the specific and detailed instructions for the building of the Tabernacle, its furniture and implements, how did God provide the help Moses would need to carry them out in Exodus 31?
2. What is the significance of God's reminder about Sabbath observance in Exodus 31:12-17?
3. What led the Israelites to demand something else to worship in Exodus 32? How do we create our own golden calves?
4. How can we cultivate a heart that is quick to repent and turn back to God when we recognize our own idolatry?
5. How does Moses' intercession for the people reveal his character and relationship with God?
6. What specific expressions does the psalmist use to describe God's strength in Psalm 21.1-3?

7. The psalmist expressed a high level of faith in this psalm. How can we cultivate a similar level of trust in God in our lives? What was the result of his trust in God?

8. According to Proverbs 7.24-25, what are the consequences of not heeding the wisdom presented in this chapter?

9. What is the main lesson that Jesus conveys through the parable of the sheep and the goats in Matthew 25.31-46?

10. What relationship do the works talked about in this passage have with salvation? Are they the means of salvation or something else?

11. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
