

# Bible in a Year Study Questions – Day 42/February 11

## Today's Readings:

Exodus 33 & 34

Psalm 21.8-13

Proverbs 8.1-5

Matthew 26.1-25

1. Exodus 33.11 mentions that "the Lord used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend." What does this reveal about the relationship between Moses and God? How can you cultivate a closer relationship with God?
2. In Exodus 34.6-7, God reveals His character to Moses. What attributes of God are emphasized in these verses, and how does understanding God's character impact our relationship with Him?
3. The covenant between God and the Israelites is reaffirmed in Exodus 34.10-28. How does the renewal of the covenant demonstrate God's faithfulness, and what responsibilities does it place on the people?
4. Exodus 34:29-35 describes the radiant face of Moses after being in the presence of God. How does this physical manifestation reflect the transformative power of being in God's presence? In what ways can we seek and reflect the glory of God in our lives?
5. What imagery is used in Psalm 21.8-9 to describe God's response to His enemies? How does this imagery reflect the power and authority of God?

6. How does the psalmist express praise and confidence in God's strength and power in verse 13?
  
7. Reflect on a time when you faced opposition or challenges. How did you rely on God's strength and authority to overcome those difficulties?
  
8. How is wisdom portrayed in Proverbs 8.1-5? What does this tell us about God's desire for us to grow in wisdom?
  
9. What is the significance of Jesus' statement in Matthew 26.2 about the approaching Passover and His imminent crucifixion? How does this set the stage for the events that follow?
  
10. Examine the reactions of the disciples to the woman's act of pouring expensive ointment on Jesus in verses 6-13. How does Jesus respond to their criticism, and what does this reveal about His priorities?
  
11. Consider Judas Iscariot's actions in verses 14-16. How does this contribute to the unfolding of the events leading to Jesus' crucifixion?
  
12. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
