

# Bible in a Year Study Questions – Day 45/February 14

## Today's Readings:

Exodus 39 & 40

Psalm 22.16-21

Proverbs 8.22-31

Matthew 27.1-26

1. The phrase “as the Lord commanded” is repeated multiple times in Exodus 39 and 40. What does that tell you?
2. Once the work on the Tabernacle was completed, Exodus 39.43 says that Moses blessed the people. What does it imply?
3. Exodus 40.34-38 says that the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. According to 1 Corinthians 6.19-20 where is God's presence manifested now?
4. How do verses 16 and 18 in Psalm 22 relate to the crucifixion of Christ?
5. As you look at the attributes of wisdom talked about in Proverbs 8.22-31. How can they be applied to Christ who is the embodiment of wisdom?
6. What events precede Matthew 27:1-26, and how do they set the stage for the events in this passage?

7. How does Pilate respond to the accusations against Jesus in Matthew 27? How do the religious leaders pressure him into condemning Him?
  
8. What does Pilate's symbolic act of washing his hands signify?
  
9. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
