

Bible in a Year Study Questions – Day 46/February 15

Today's Readings:

Leviticus 1 & 2

Psalm 22.22-31

Proverbs 8.32-36

Matthew 27.27-54

1. What was the purpose of the burnt offering in Leviticus 1? What does it point forward to in the New Testament?
2. What specific instructions did God give regarding the type of animals that could be used for the burnt offering? Why did the animals need to be without blemish?
3. What was the reason there could be no leaven or honey mixed with the grain offering in Leviticus 2? What was the importance of adding salt to the grain offering?
4. In what ways can we see the principles of the grain offering in the concept of presenting our bodies as living sacrifices (Romans 12:1)?
5. How does the tone of Psalm 22 change in these concluding verses compared to the earlier verses?
6. What does Proverbs 8.32-35 teach us about God's blessings and what leads to them? What does it mean in verse 36 that those who hate wisdom love death?

7. How was Jesus mocked and humiliated by the soldiers in Matthew 27.27-31?

8. Describe the scene of Jesus' crucifixion as depicted in verses 32-38. What details stand out to you, and what do they reveal about the severity of Jesus' suffering?

9. Examine the various reactions to Jesus' crucifixion in verses 39-44. How do different groups, including those passing by, the chief priests, and the robbers, respond to Jesus?

10. What is the significance of the temple curtain being torn in two in verses 51-52.

11. Consider the centurion's confession in verse 54. How does his acknowledgment of Jesus as the Son of God reflect a transformation in understanding and belief?

12. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
