1. What types of unintentional sins required a sin offering according to Leviticus 5? How does unintentional sin differ from intentional sin?
2. Why is confession emphasized in the process of offering a sin offering?
3. Leviticus 5 mentions different offerings for various economic situations. What does this teach about God's consideration of those things?
4. Leviticus 6 introduces the trespass offering. How does it differ from the sin offering in terms of purpose and application? Why do you think restitution was an important part?
5. Leviticus 6:8-13 discusses the perpetual burnt offering. What does the perpetuity of this offering signify?
6. What is meant by "clean hands" and "a pure heart" in Psalm 24?

7. What difference do you see in Proverbs 9.7-9 between the foolish scoffer and the wise man or woman?

8. Describe the different actions of the women, the guards, and the religious leaders in Matthew 28. What do they reveal about their hearts?

9. Examine the Great Commission in verses 18-20. What specific tasks does Jesus assign to His disciples, and how does this commission apply to believers today? What do you believe God wants you to do with this passage?

10. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
