1. Why does God emphasize bringing slain animals to the door of the Tabernacle in Leviticus 17.3-4?
2. Explain verse 11 in your own words. Why is it such an important theological statement? What is the spiritual significance of blood according to this verse?
3. In what ways do the instructions in this chapter point to the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus Christ?
4. What does Leviticus 18.6-18 forbid?
5. List the other prohibitions in verses 19-23.
6. What would be the result if the Israelites failed to obey these commandments?
7. What does Psalm 27.1-3 tell us about David's faith and trust in God?

8. David said he would not give in to the fear of man in verse 3. Who does Psalm 33.18 tell us we are to trust?

9. What confidence can a man or woman who walks in integrity have according to Proverbs 10.9? What about the person who perverts his or her way?

10. Explain Mark 4.21-23 in your own words.

11. How does the Parable of the Growing Seed describe the Kingdom of God?

12. What does the Parable of the Mustard Seed teach us about the Kingdom of God?

13. In verses 35-41 Jesus calms the storm. What is the disciples' response? How does Jesus rebuke them?

14. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
