- 5. List the other prohibitions in verses 19-23.
- 6. What would be the result if the Israelites failed to obey these commandments?
- 7. What does Psalm 27.1-3 tell us about David's faith and trust in God?

- 8. David said he would not give in to the fear of man in verse 3. Who does Psalm 33.18 tell us we are to trust?
- 9. What confidence can a man or woman who walks in integrity have according to Proverbs 10.9? What about the person who perverts his or her way?
- 10. Explain Mark 4.21-23 in your own words.
- 11. How does the Parable of the Growing Seed describe the Kingdom of God?
- 12. What does the Parable of the Mustard Seed teach us about the Kingdom of God?
- 13. In verses 35-41 Jesus calms the storm. What is the disciples' response? How does Jesus rebuke them?
