1.	The main theme of Leviticus is holiness. How is it to be lived out according to Leviticus 19 and 20?
2.	What do today's readings have to say about divination and witchcraft? Have you participated in these things? If so, is there something you need to take to the Lord and seek His forgiveness?
3.	What instructions are given concerning the poor?
4.	The psalmist expresses his desire for an intimate relationship with God as dwelling in the house of the Lord in Psalm 27.4? Do you need to make this more of a priority in your life?
5.	How does the psalmist express his confidence in God's protection in Psalm 27.4-10?
6.	How does the psalmist express his trust in God's deliverance from enemies? Is there an area where you need to trust God more?

7.	What does verse 10 tell us about the contrast between human relationship and our trust in God?
8.	What does Proverbs 10.10 tell us about the verbal and non-verbal communication of the wicked?
9.	How does Proverbs 10.11 contrast the communication of the wicked and the righteous?
10.	What does verse 12 teach us about our willingness to overlook some sins?
11.	What was the condition of the demon-possessed man before his encounter with Jesus in Mark 5.1-20?
12.	What was the reaction of the demons and what does it tell us about Jesus' authority?
13.	What was the reaction of the people in the area to both the miracle of the man's deliverance and what happened with the herd of pigs? Why do you think they asked Jesus to leave their area?
14.	What did the formerly demon-possessed man ask of Jesus and what was Jesus' response?
15.	Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
