3.	How did the majority of the spies respond to the challenges they encountered in Canaan?	
4.	How did Caleb and Joshua differ from the other spies in their report?	
5.	What was the response of the Israelites to the majority report? What consequences did the Israelites face due to their lack of faith?	
6.	How did God respond to the Israelites' lack of faith? What mercy did God show to certain individuals in the midst of judgment?	
7.	What can we learn about faith, trust, and obedience from this passage?	

8.	What was God's plan for the new generation that would enter the Promised Land in Numbers 14? Did the people show any signs of repentance during this period?
9.	Despite the general unbelief, were there individuals who remained faithful to God during this time? How can you learn from their example?
10.	According to Psalm 31.19, what is the nature of God's goodness? How has God shown His goodness to you in your life?
11.	In what ways does the psalmist describe God as a refuge in verses 20 and 21?
12.	According to verses 21-22, what blessings are promised to those who trust in the Lord?
13.	In what way does the psalmist contrast fear and trust in verse 23?
14.	What final affirmation does the psalmist make in verse 24?
15.	What is the main message of Proverbs 11:15 regarding surety or acting as a guarantor? How can this verse be applied to modern financial situations and decisions?
16.	Why do James and John approach Jesus with their request in Mark 10:35-37? How does Jesus correct their misunderstandings?

17.	How does Jesus' teaching on greatness and servanthood challenge your own understanding of leadership and success?
18.	According to Mark 10:29-30, what promise does Jesus make to those who leave everything to follow Him?
19.	Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
