

Bible in a Year Study Questions – Day 83 - March 24

Today's Readings:

Deuteronomy 9 & 10

Psalm 37.12-17

Proverbs 12.11

Luke 1.57-80

1. What is the context of Deuteronomy 9? What events led up to this chapter?
2. In verses 1-3, what reassurance does God give to the Israelites as they prepare to enter the Promised Land?
3. How does Moses remind the Israelites of their rebellious behavior in verses 4-6? What lessons can we learn from their mistakes?
4. Reflect on verses 7-12. What do these verses reveal about God's faithfulness despite Israel's unfaithfulness?
5. According to verses 13-21, how did Moses intercede for the people when they sinned with the golden calf? What can we learn from his prayer life?
6. Verses 22-24 describe other instances of Israel's rebellion. How does this reinforce the theme of God's mercy?

7. How does Moses' prayer in verses 25-29 show his concern for God's reputation and the well-being of the people?
8. In Deuteronomy 10.1-5, why did Moses make new tablets of stone, and what was written on them? What does this reveal about God's mercy and the importance of His commandments?
9. Reflect on verses 12-13. What does it mean to fear the Lord, walk in His ways, love Him, serve Him, and keep His commandments?
10. What do verses 14-22 teach us about God's care for the fatherless, widows, and strangers?
11. According to Psalm 37.12, how do the wicked plot against the righteous?
12. According to verse 14, how does God respond to the wicked's schemes?
13. According to Proverbs 12.11, what characterizes the labor of the diligent? How can we apply the principles in this verse to our lives?
14. Describe the circumstances surrounding the birth of John the Baptist as depicted in Luke 1.57-66.
15. Analyze Zechariah's prophecy in verses 67-79. What key themes or messages does he express?

16. In what ways do the events surrounding John's birth point to the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies about the coming of the Messiah?

17. Reflect on Zechariah's description of John's role in verses 76-77. What does it mean for John to "prepare the way for the Lord"?

18. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
