1.	According to Deuteronomy 13, what is God's warning about false prophets?
2.	Consider verses 6-11. What are the consequences of turning away from the Lord and following after other gods?
3.	Reflect on verse 4. What is the fundamental call to action for God's people in the face of false prophets and idolatry? In what ways does loyalty to God protect His people from the dangers of false prophets and idolatry?
4.	Consider the temptations and pressures to compromise your faith in today's world. How can the teachings of Deuteronomy 13 help you navigate these challenges?
5.	What might be the purpose behind the dietary laws in Deuteronomy 14, and how do they distinguish Israel from other nations?
6.	Reflect on verses 22-29. What instructions does God give regarding tithing? According to verses 22-27, what is the purpose of tithing? How does it relate to worshiping God?

7.	Consider verses 28-29. What blessings does God promise to those who faithfully obey His commandments regarding tithing?
8.	What is the central message or theme of Psalm 37:23-29?
9.	Reflect on verse 23. What does it mean for the steps of the righteous to be "ordered by the Lord"?
10.	Consider verse 24. How does the psalmist describe the experience of the righteous when they stumble or fall? What does this verse reveal about God's commitment to uphold and support those who trust in Him?
11.	Reflect on Proverbs 12.15-16. What contrast is made between the wise and the fool in verse 15 in terms of their response to advice? What does it mean for the fool to trust in their own way?
12.	How does the wise person respond differently to anger compared to the fool in verse 16?
13.	Reflect on Luke 2.25-52. What does Simeon proclaim about Jesus, and how does he respond to seeing Him?
14.	Consider the role of Anna in verses 36-38. What does she do upon seeing Jesus, and how does she respond to His presence?

15. In what ways can you share the good news of Jesus with others, following the examples of the shepherds, Simeon, and Anna?
16. Which passage in today's reading impacted you the most? Is there a verse you would like to memorize and/or meditate on today?
